Princess Di's Name Lives On

The Complainant, the authorized representative of The Diana, Princess of Wales Memorial Fund, was awarded the domain names "princessdi.com" and "princessdiana.com" in this recent UDRP decision.

The Respondent had made no use of the domain names since registration in 1997. Only after notice of the Complainant's intention to begin arbitration proceedings did the Respondent link the domain names to websites containing disparaging information about the Complainant and an unrelated commercial website.

As a result, the Panel determined that the Respondent had no rights in the domain name, and had registered and used the domain name in bad faith.
